



Dear Parents

Borrowing at the school library is up and running (Kindergarten begin in Week 4). There are many exciting new texts and series being introduced and shared during library lessons and the children are motivated to borrow.

Please remember it is important that the children bring their library bag each week when borrowing and returning books to ensure the books are protected when transported to and from home. Senior students (Years 5 & 6) have been given the option of bringing a bag (to ensure books are safe) or taking a responsible approach to taking the book home if they don't bring a bag. I have reminded the students that with responsibility and choice there are consequences, so if the books are damaged in transit, the students will need to pay a replacement fee.

All students from K – 4 will require a bag to take books home. (Bags may be purchased at the school for \$5.00 until stocks last).

Many thanks to my wonderful book covering helpers who make it possible to get the new books covered and circulating so quickly into our library. If there are any other parents that would like to help with keeping the library running efficiently please let me know.

Finally, if you have any indoor games that you have at home that your children no longer use we can always make use of them for the lunch time library and games club.
